

## What's New in ASC Promotion and Tenure 2023-2024

- 1) Vita has been taken offline as of August 1, 2023. All references to VITA have been deleted from the handbook.
- 2) Interfolio – Submission of dossiers has moved to Interfolio. See the [ASC Interfolio P&T Submission Process](#) document for detailed guidance.
- 3) Form 109 – this form is not required for the 2023-24 P&T cycle.
- 4) Form 105 – this form has been replaced by multiple Interfolio forms. See the [ASC Interfolio P&T Submission Process](#) document for detailed guidance.
- 5) Teaching, item 2ai – Doctoral Students (dissertation advisor): Candidates are now required to include the following information for current advisees: name of student and year advising began.
- 6) Teaching, item 9 – Other Academic Advising: Candidates should briefly describe academic advising of students and examples may now include consistent informal mentoring.
- 7) Research, item 5 – Research Funding: In cases of multiple authorship for funded and proposed grants noted below, a narrative description of the candidate's intellectual contribution to the grant proposal is required.
- 8) Research, item 5c – Research Funding: a new funded research category has been added for Funded research, including contracts and clinical trials, on which the candidate is or has been senior personnel. Proposals for research funding are now at item 5d.
